

FY2009 OMNIBUS FEDERAL FUNDING

Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

Project: \$ 238,000 - Riverside Unified School District Virtual School Program

The entity to receive the funding for this project is the Riverside Unified School District, located at 3380 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. The \$238,000 in funding will be used to provide additional curricular content for the online education program.

Project: \$476,000 - Riverside County Office of Education School Dropout Prevention and Student Success Initiative

The entity to receive the funding for this project is the Riverside Country Office of Education, located at 3939 13th Street, Riverside California 92501. The \$476,000 in funding will be used to conduct research and implement reforms to address the origins of students dropping out and to devise solutions to keep students in school and promote their academic success.

Project: \$238,000 - California Baptist University Equipment Modernization and Health Care Training Initiative

The entity to receive funding for this project is California Baptist University, located at 8432 Magnolia Avenue, Riverside, California 92504. The \$238,000 in funding will be used to purchase specialized equipment for the School of Engineering and the School of Nursing.

Project: \$143,000 - La Sierra University Integrated Biological and Physical Science Laboratory

The entity to receive funding for this project is La Sierra University, located at 4500 Riverwalk Parkway, Riverside, California 92515. The \$143,000 in funding will be used to purchase equipment for an integrated biological and physical science laboratory.

Project: \$333,000 - Riverside Community College District Allied Health Sciences Program.

The entity receiving funding is Riverside Community College District, located at 4800 Magnolia Avenue, Riverside, California 92506. The \$333,000 in funding will be used to purchase equipment for the Allied Health Sciences Program.

Project: \$523,000 - Riverside County Regional Medical Center Facilities and Equipment Funding

The entity receiving funding is Riverside County Regional Medical Center, located at 26520 Cactus Avenue, Riverside, California 92555. The \$523,000 in funding will be used to expand and renovate the trauma unit at the Riverside County Regional Medical Center.

Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

Project: \$330,000 - Interoperability Equipment for City of Corona, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Corona Police Department, located at 849 W. Sixth Street, Corona, California, 92882. The funding would be used to replace outdated communication technology through the purchase of new equipment including new microwave dishes, control station antennas, and new local base station radio equipment.

Project: \$325,000 - Public Safety Wireless Network for City of Corona, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Corona Police Department, located at 849 W. Sixth Street, Corona, California, 92882. The funding would be used to complete work on a high speed wireless network to allow mobile access by Police Officers and Firefighters to the City wireless network and other resources available through the internet. The funding would be used to purchase approximately 10 to 12 base station/repeaters with a mobile device to be installed in each City police and fire vehicle.

Project: \$500,000 - DNA Expansion Project for Office of Orange County District Attorney, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Office of the Orange County District Attorney, located at 401 Civic Center Drive West, Santa Ana, California, 92701. The funding would be used to purchase DNA mobile collection vehicles and related equipment, supplies and DNA processing.

Project: \$500,000 - Automated Kiosk Reporting System, Riverside County, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Riverside County Probation Department, located at 3801 University Avenue, Suite 400 Riverside, California, 92501. The funding would be used to purchase 15 automated kiosk reporting systems to be placed at government buildings throughout the county at where offenders would report on a regular basis as directed by their probation officer.

Project: \$1.925M - Regional Fingerprint Identification Project - Riverside and San Bernardino Counties, CA

The entities to receive funding for this project are the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, located at 4095 Lemon Street, Riverside, California 92501, and the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department, located at 655 East Third Street, San Bernardino, California 92415. The funding would be used for ongoing product development, research and pilot programs of the identification project which provides fingerprint, photo and DNA services to all public safety agencies including local police departments, district attorney, school districts, coroner and Sheriffs' Departments in Riverside and San Bernardino counties.

Project: \$895,000 - Public Safety Interoperability System, Riverside, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Riverside, located at 3900 Main Street, Riverside, California, 92522. The funding would be used for the purchase of satellite phones as well as the acquisition, installation, and first year maintenance of Internet Protocol (IP) based radio "gateways" and Mobile Satellite WLAN/IP Broadband to achieve interoperability.

Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

Project: \$134,000 - Municipal Water District of Orange County for Efficient Irrigation, California

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Municipal Water District of Orange County, located at 10500 Ellis Avenue, Fountain Valley, CA 92728. The funding would be used to continue the installation of a smart irrigation controller system that uses cutting edge technology to regulate the amount of water that is delivered based on weather conditions, soil, slope, and type of landscape.

Project: \$1,531,000 - Pierce's Disease, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the University of California, Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources, located at 1111 Franklin Street, 6th Floor, Oakland, CA 94607. The requested funding will allow the University of California to conduct competitive research projects for Pierce's Disease focusing on wine-grape growing regions and counties as well as for Invasive Species emphasizing on high priority introductions.

Energy and Water Development and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

Project: \$369,000 - Aliso Creek, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used for the Aliso Creek, CA watershed project in Orange County, CA.

Project: \$215,000 - Heacock and Cactus Channels, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used for the Heacock and Cactus Channels flood control project in southern California.

Project: \$339,000 - Riverside County Special Area Management Plan, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used to complete work on the Riverside County SAMP for the San Jacinto and Santa Margarita River Watersheds in Riverside County, CA.

Project: \$382,000 - San Clemente Shoreline, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used for a shoreline protection project in San Clemente, CA.

Project: \$717,000 - San Juan Creek, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used for the San Juan Creek flood control project in Orange County, CA.

Project: \$3,349,000 - Murrieta Creek, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used for the Murrieta Creek, CA flood control project in Riverside County, CA.

Project: \$14,000,000 - Santa Ana River Mainstem, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The

funding would be used for the Santa Ana River Mainstem flood control project in southern California.

Project: \$946,000 - South Perris, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used to produce potable water from an otherwise unusable groundwater resource through the construction of a three million-gallon per day reverse osmosis desalter, feed-water pipelines, and brackish water wells in the Perris South sub-basin.

Project: \$2,871,000 - Upper Newport Bay, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, located at 915 Wilshire Blvd. Suite 980, Los Angeles, CA 90017. The funding would be used for the Upper Newport Bay ecosystem restoration project in Orange County, CA.

Project: \$5,000,000 - Inland Empire Regional Water Recycling Project

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Inland Empire Utilities Agency, located at 6075 Kimball Avenue, Chino, CA 91710. The funding would be for continued construction of the Inland Empire Regional Water Recycling Project in California.

Project: \$540,000 - Orange County Regional Water Reclamation Project

I The entity to receive funding for these projects is the Orange County Water District, located at 10500 Ellis Avenue, Fountain Valley, CA 92708. The funding would be used for the completion of the Orange County Regional Water Reclamation Project in Orange County, CA.

Project: \$100,000 - Riverside – Corona Feeder

The entity to receive funding for these projects is the Western Municipal Water District, located at 450 Alessandro Boulevard, Riverside, CA, 92508. The funding would continue the feasibility study for the Riverside-Corona Feeder project. The project proposes to manage the ground water levels by the construction of ground water wells and pumping capacity to deliver the pumped ground water supply to water users. A new water conveyance pipeline is also proposed that will serve western Riverside County.

Department of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

Project: \$500,000 - City of Norco, Norco Water Treatment Plant Improvements

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Norco, located at 2870 Clarke Avenue, Norco, CA 92860. It is my understanding that the funding would be used for water treatment facilities in the City of Norco, CA.

Project: \$300,000 - Orange County Sanitation District, OCSD Secondary Treatment Upgrades

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Orange County Sanitation District, located at 10844 Ellis Avenue, Fountain Valley, CA 92646. It is my understanding that the funding would be used for construction of upgraded wastewater treatment facilities in Orange County, CA.

Project: \$2,000,000 - Water Information Sharing and Analysis Center / Association of Metropolitan Water Agencies

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Association of Metropolitan Water Agencies, located at 1620 I Street, NW, Suite 500, Washington, DC, 20006. It is my understanding that the funding would be used for intelligence collection and analysis in support of state drinking water agencies, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the Department of Homeland Security. WaterISAC shares intelligence and security threat information with general managers and security managers of public water agencies throughout the nation.

Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

Project: \$950,000 - Multi-modal Transit Centers, Riverside and Corona, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Riverside Transit Agency located at 1825 Third Street, Riverside, CA, 92507. The funding would be for the construction of transit centers in cities of Riverside and Corona, CA.

Project: \$237,000 - San Diego Freeway (I-5) Widening and Improvement, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Orange County Transportation Authority located at 550 South Main Street, Orange, CA, 92863. It is my understanding that the funding would be used to add additional freeway capacity along Interstate 5 in south Orange County with consideration for a potential connection with planned San Diego County high occupancy vehicle lanes on Interstate 5.

Project: \$570,000 - Alameda Corridor East Grade Separations, Riverside County, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Riverside County Transportation Commission, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 3rd Floor, Riverside, CA 92501. It is my understanding that the funding would be used to construct grade separations in Riverside County. The Riverside County Transportation Commission would use the funds to address the 61 at-grade highway-rail crossings on the mainline of the Union Pacific and Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroad lines in Riverside County.

Project: \$475,000 - SR-91 Improvements, Orange and Riverside Counties, CA

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Orange County Transportation Authority, located at 550 South Main Street, Orange, CA 92868. It is my understanding that the funding would be used to make improvements along SR-91, including the SR-91/SR-55 interchange, SR-241 interchange and adding one lane in each direction along the SR-91 from the SR-241 to the Orange and Riverside County line.
