# CONGRESSMAN KEN CALVERT SECURES MORE THAN **\$67 MILLION** FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS



Rep. Calvert joined President Trump in the Oval Office as he signed legislation that included more than \$67 million for Riverside County infrastructure projects. As a senior member of the Appropriations Committee, Rep. Calvert secured the funding by working closely with the communities he represents.

In just the past few years, Rep. Calvert has secured more than \$20 million in federal funding for transportation, homeless, water, and health care projects in the Corona and Norco region. Approved federal funding requests by Members of Congress for local projects are allocated within their respective agency program accounts and do not raise the overall spending level of the bill.

## **REP. KEN CALVERT DELIVERS \$5.7 MILLION FOR CORONA PROJECTS**

Congressman Calvert secured federal funding for the following Corona projects in the recently enacted appropriations bills:

### **\$4 million for the Magnolia Avenue Widening Project**

The project will ease congestion by widening Magnolia Avenue from El Camino Avenue to Leeson Lane to increase travel lanes from four to six.

### **\$1.7 million for the Corona Trails Improvement Project**

The project will construct improvements, amenities, and new trails in the city and along the interface with Cleveland National Forest.
