CONGRESSMAN KEN CALVERT SECURES MORE THAN **\$67 MILLION** FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS



Rep. Calvert joined President Trump in the Oval Office as he signed legislation that included more than \$67 million for Riverside County infrastructure projects. REP. KEN CALVERT DELIVERS \$7.5 MILLION FOR MENIFEE PROJECTS

Congressman Calvert secured federal funding for the following Menifee projects in the recently enacted appropriations bills:

\$2.5 million for the Scott Road/Bundy Canyon Road Widening Project

The funding will advance the widening of the Bundy Canyon Road/Scott Road corridor connecting the cities of Menifee and Wildomar.

\$5 million for the Quail Valley Septic to Sewer Conversion Project

The funding will continue work on the septic-to-sewer conversion project in the Quail Valley area, which will improve water quality for the immediate community as well as the entire watershed.
