## President Trump and Rep. Calvert are Delivering Results

### Historic Reductions in Illegal Immigration:

Illegal border crossings have plummeted to their lowest level since the 1970s, with migrant encounters at the U.S.-Mexico border dropping dramatically in 2025<sup>1</sup>.

Removing Criminals: More than 400,000 illegal immigrants charged with or convicted of crimes have been removed from the country<sup>2</sup>.

Zero Releases and Strong Deterrence: No illegal immigrants have been released into the interior for nine straight months<sup>3</sup>.
