

On behalf of the City of Lake Elsinore, we respectfully request your support for several Community Designation Funding (CDF) requests that will strengthen public safety, expand healthcare access, improve infrastructure resilience, and support continued economic growth within Riverside County. As Lake Elsinore continues to experience rapid residential and commercial development, strategic federal partnership is critical to ensure that infrastructure and emergency services keep pace with the region’s growth.

The City is seeking federal support for four critical projects that address wildfire resilience, emergency response capacity, transportation reliability, and healthcare access for residents across Southwest Riverside County.

1. Nichols Road Bridge and Corridor Improvement Project

Total Project Cost: \$28M

City Contribution: \$2M

Federal Funding Request: \$6M

The Nichols Road Bridge Project will replace and modernize critical infrastructure serving North Lake Elsinore's industrial corridor. The current bridge and roadway alignment are vulnerable to flooding and storm damage, creating safety hazards and limiting reliable access for residents, emergency responders, and commercial vehicles.

The project includes bridge construction, roadway realignment, and drainage improvements to:

- Strengthen infrastructure resilience and prevent flood-related failures
- Improve emergency access reliability
- Support freight mobility and economic development
- Enable continued growth of the region's industrial base

Modernizing this corridor is essential to maintaining safe and reliable transportation infrastructure while supporting the economic competitiveness of the region.

2. Tuscany Hills Emergency Access Road Project

Total Project Cost: \$35,000,000

City Contribution: \$3,000,000

Federal Funding Request: \$6,000,000

The Tuscany Hills community currently relies on a single access road for approximately 1,431 homes, multiple parks, and an elementary school. As wildfire risks increase across California, reliance on a single evacuation route presents significant public safety concern.

The Tuscany Hills Emergency Access Road Project will construct a secondary access route to:

- Provide a critical wildfire evacuation route
- Improve emergency response access for fire, medical, and law enforcement services
- Reduce evacuation congestion and improve disaster preparedness
- Strengthen safety for thousands of residents and schoolchildren

Federal funding will help deliver this life-saving infrastructure improvement for a community located in a high wildfire risk region.

4. Alberhill Fire Station Project

Total Project Cost: \$11M

Federal Funding Request: \$3M

The Alberhill Fire Station will serve the rapidly growing Alberhill Specific Plan area and surrounding North Lake Elsinore communities, as well as portions of south Corona and unincorporated Riverside County. Rapid residential and commercial growth in the region has placed significant strain on existing fire stations, increasing response times and stretching emergency personnel resources.

This project will construct a new fire station to:

- Improve emergency response times for residents and businesses
- Enhance wildfire preparedness in a high fire-threat region
- Support responsible residential and commercial growth
- Reduce operational strain on existing fire stations

With developer partnership through land dedication already secured, federal investment will help ensure that critical public safety infrastructure keeps pace with development and population growth.
